I've attached a more detailed prayer guide for the upcoming Israel trip. Please print out and lift up our team of 16 people including myself as often as you remember.

I have a wonderful opportunity to travel to Israel to connect with many missions and congregations serving the Lord and giving a witness for Jesus to Jews, Arabs, Sudanese, Bedouins and other ethnic groups. Through special arrangement with British Airlines we will be bringing two extra suitcases each filled with supplies and materials for these missions. Some of you may recall that recently there was a tragic and horrific fire in the Mt. Carmel area of Northern Israel. One of the places we will visit is a Jewish Christian congregation situated near the fire area.

I am going to learn about the different ministries and pray for guidance about returning to help and to also bring other believers for short term mission trips to assist one or two of the missions. We will also be involved in intercessory prayer in various locations and distributing Gospel material as God opens doors. Some of the additional missions I will contact in Israel that are not listed in the attached detailed itinerary possibly are Ilya Lizorkin in Haifa, Jews for Jesus in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem, and others.

I and our team knows that without prayer we cannot accomplish the Lord's will. So, print out the itinerary and pray for the team and myself. A total of sixteen people will travel together. Pray for unity good working relations.

The trip will cost \$2,500 plus insurance and personal needs. At present we have received \$675.00 in donations toward the mission trip. Please pray about helping with this expense.

Bible Study with Jewish people

My church's assistant pastor moved into an apartment building filled with Jewish residents. He began a Bible discussion group and invited me to participate. On Thursday, I attended for the first time and was well received. We discussed Gen. 4 and some of the topics that came up were; the root of evil (external circumstances or inner problems), the different spiritual route that Cain's family took vs. Shem's, and other subjects. One of the attendees name Evelyn made a profound statement. Even though she was raised by atheist Jewish parents, she said the root of Western Civilization was the Scriptures and she was appreciative. Pray for Evelyn, Pauline, Thelma, AL, and Harry (not sure on this name). We meet weekly. Pray for a step by step understanding of the need to repent and believe in Messiah Jesus.

Home Sale

Our home is under contract. Pray God will help finalize the sale as the potential buyer has some concerns about mechanics of our property.

Easter Preaching Tour

As of now I have 5 meetings scheduled and I'm still working on filling in Wednesday April 20th. I am preaching in S. AL & the Western FL panhandle. It's been hard to call churches with all the other busy issues, particularly the home sale and P.T. However, I will continue to call as I can. If you know of a church in these areas that might be open to my ministry of Christ in the Passover or Christ in First Fruits and Pentecost, please let me know.

I've been discharged from physical therapy and continue to exercise. Pray I make the time to visit the gym. Things get very hectic at times and its easy to skip the necessary exercise some of which is best done at the gym. Recently, I had a back problem caused by moving heavy fallen tree branches. Praise the Lord things have improved and I am getting back to regular back exercises to prevent future problems
