MISSION REPORT

Dear Supporters and Friends of AMMI Ministry,

Here is a summary of our evangelism outreach planned for the Democratic National Convention July 22–29.

Jews for Jesus from Washington DC and NYC, and Chosen People missionaries from Philadelphia will be part of the seven-day evangelism outreach. Additional experienced evangelists from St. Louis, Cherry Hill, New Jersey, and Boston will be joining us.

The Center City Philadelphia church, which has been our headquarters for the last three campaigns, is opening their doors again to us. Any effort like this involves spiritual warfare, so pray for God to empower the missionaries and to bind Satan and demons from interfering with us.

The Campaign will begin on Saturday, July 23rd. We Will HAVE A PRAYER TABLE and our message T-shirts will draw people's attention. Also, all the missionaries working with us are trained in public proclamation through tract evangelism and proficient in initiating conversations and sharing the gospel.

On Saturday, July 23, we will have an outreach from 10 AM to 2 PM. On Monday through Thursday (7/25-28) we will be starting at 6:30 in the morning at our headquarters at 22nd and Mount Vernon streets. We will go out three times during the day to connect with people and share the gospel. The times are from 7 AM to 10 AM, 11 AM to 1 PM, and 4 PM to 6 PM.

We will have teams along Arch street between Broad and 11th street to cover Convention Hall, where many of the meetings will take place for the DNC (democratic national convention committee). Another area of concentration will be the transportation centers in the morning and evening rush-hours. We will have people in the Jefferson, Suburban, PATCO, and 30th St. Stations and at the hotel in Center City where the Democrats are staying.

During the lunch hour we will spread out through Center City including the Reading

Terminal (a busy lunch and shopping farmers market) and focus on beginning conversations with passersby. We will also set up three tables. One of these will be a prayer station and the other two will be literature tables. All three tables will have banners in front to draw people's attention. This is the time of day when people have more time to discuss the Gospel.

Our T-shirt design contains the Star of David, and our experience shows this will draw contact with Jewish people. However, the majority of people we will speak with are Gentiles. We have specially prepared literature that will be effective with both groups. After we've spoken with somebody, whenever possible we will give them a gospel booklet or the Gospel of John. Those who work with us are trained not only to talk with people but to encourage them to give us their contact information for follow-up.

It still is not too late to participate with us. If you're physically limited but still want to help, there's a couple of options. You could be a steward back at our church headquarters and help prepare food and restock tract bags as the missionaries return, or you may sit at one of the outreach tables and talk to people as they approach. Please let your church members know of this need. We are limiting volunteers to those who have gone through our training or have experience in public evangelism.

Prayer Needs for the Campaign

1. Additional experienced street evangelist to join our efforts.
2. Safety for campaigners.
3. That God will prepare the hearts of those with whom we come into contact, that they may be responsive or open to learning more about Jesus and salvation.
4. That our shirts, banners, signs, and literature will be effective in raising the issue of Jesus before a cynical and hardened world.
5. That our volunteers who are in their late teens or early 20s can have an effective outreach to similar aged high school and college students.
6. Meals for the volunteer campaigners. We need both lunch/dinner meals that can feed eight people--Rotisserie chickens, breakfast casseroles, fruit and vegetable trays, snack bars, cookies, and cases of water. Please call Ron or Donna at 267-269-9299 for more details. Available meals will make it possible for the campaigners to have maximum time for rest between witnessing sessions.
7. For good relationships between the campaigners, the leaders, and the City and transportation authorities.

8. For wisdom in planning where the campaigners will be, and for physical strength and endurance for those witnessing in the July heat.
9. That all the material items needed for the campaign will be gathered. This includes Bibles tracts, hand wipes, water, snacks, suntan lotion, skin cream, and other such items.
10. For the financial resources to cover the cost for this outreach.
11. For physical protection from hostile people.
12. For spiritual discernment and the liberty to freely share the Gospel.
