

Philly Witness Team Report At Political Rally



Albert relates his experience witnessing at the above political rally;

"Hey all," as Geoffrey (our board president) said to me when we were leaving the event, "that was fun!" and I agreed. I was not sure what to expect when I got there but was pleasantly surprised. Republicans had a strong presence there in fact, it seemed like there were more Republicans than Democrats! There was a plane flying overhead with a banner that said "S Jersey is Trump Country". I started by walking around the Republicans who were across the street from the gym with their banners and flags. I was able to hand out some tracts and get into some short conversations and was able to talk about the gospel to a few. I met up with Geoffrey and after a couple more conversations went to the line of Democrats waiting to get in. At first, I would try to hand a tract and say "do you know what the gospel is?" but no takers. Then I just handed out the tracts without a conversation starter. That is when people were accepted them. I could not hand them out fast enough. I had to take off one of my gloves to hand out the tracts. Of course, if someone asked me what it was, I would tell them that it is a gospel tract.

I went back to the Republican side and went up to a man and tried to hand him with a tract saying "This is a gospel tract, do you know what the gospel is?" and he said that's OK, I am good" and I said "No one is good that is why our Lord Jesus died for us". He then came back and took a tract.

There were Republican speakers there as well and plenty of chants of "Four more years" on the Republican side which made it a fun experience. Please pray for the hundreds of tracts that were handed out and for those who we were able to talk with as well."

Transportation Center Evangelism

On another date Albert and 2 volunteer stayed near a busy train station to hand out tracts and initiate Gospel conversations. Here is his report,
"Traffic did not seem any less [because of the virus] on my way over to the station but the station was certainly not as busy when we were there. A bus came in to drop off people at the train station. It was slow going at first. Then, I stopped and prayed, and people started to accept the tracts. I only had one conversation. Fortunately, Ernie Jr was there as well to talk with a young man. He asked us why would God send His son to die for us? He said "would you send your son to die for people that you do not know?" Ernie Jr. said that Jesus was God ordained to be resurrected from the dead. I added that the fact that He was resurrected, showed that God accepted His perfect sacrifice. The young man seemed happy with that but had to go. He said that he would read the gospel tract that I gave him."

The value of street witnessing

Some Christians minimize the value of street witnessing. They often believe friendship evangelism is the best way to reach people. What they don't understand is God uses all forms of witnessing. What Albert and Geoff do by going out to public areas is either water seeds planted by others, or plant seeds that will be watered by others. Occasionally, people will respond ask the Lord into their lives, then our team will follow up with these folks and try to bring them to a good church. Sunny regularly speaks with Sam on the telephone and helps him learn more about Jesus. Sam is still struggling with depression and needs a job. Please pray God will strengthen Sam spiritual heart and open up a job opportunity.

One of AMMI's supporters has blessed us with a donation that will cover the cost of the television ministry for a year. We are greatly encouraged by this wonderful gift. Meanwhile, funds are still needed for the church's rent and utilities, evangelism supplies, health insurance, and general living expenses for Sunny and his family.
