9/2 Evangelism Report

On Friday, 9/2, we went to the heart of Center City across from the government building on 15th St. near Market. With me were Dan Levy and my wife Donna. We were able to comfort and encourage several Christians who are struggling with assurance of salvation.

Donna covered our literature table, and was able to have many conversations. She was very approachable with her welcoming smile - see picture below.



Dan began a conversation with a Jewish man named V. from Ukraine (Picture below showing Dan and V. walking over to literature table). He is very interested and wants to discuss the gospel further.



I also had several conversations with a church member and a pastor who expressed interest in having me come and teach them about witnessing to Jewish people. Altogether we had five contacts that need to be followed up. Hundreds of other people saw our witness T-shirt.

When we stand in the mist of a walking crowd of people, you learn to hand out tracks in a variety of ways. While I was handing out tracks I was explaining to people that neither Hillary nor Donald could bring peace to their hearts or souls. Only Jesus could provide peace with God. I urged them to choose Jesus by repenting, believing, and submitting to him.





Several people we met have contact with Jewish people. We gave them a book on messianic prophecy in the Jewish Scriptures which they agreed to give to their Jewish family members and contacts. Please pray they will follow through, and the unsaved Jewish people will read the book.

In spite of temperatures in the mid 90s we had a very effective outreach. We had many conversations with both saved and unsaved people.

Conversations with two Jewish people

I had a significant half-hour conversation with Rabbi H. The rabbi is a man in his early 30s who practices and teaches the spiritual/mystical side of Judaism. He teaches the Kabbalah which is a derivative, with a Jewish twist, of Platonism and gnosticism. Because I am familiar with these teachings, I was able to engage in an in-depth conversation with him. His goal in conversation was for me to put on phylacteries as a way of obeying God. By doing this, according to the rabbinical understanding of Deuteronomy 6, it would bring a blessing on the earth, capture part of creation back to God, and bring me spiritually closer to God.

I explained that I was already close to God because of what Jesus did for me and went on to further explain the gospel of grace. I enjoyed our conversation because he is a sincere seeker of God and was not hostile to my faith in Jesus. He gave me his contact information for further communication. Please pray for him, he's sincerely wanting to please God through his works.

Opportunities for Conversations about the Gospel

Picture below is of Michael with his back to us on the right, an active evangelist, engaging a **Jewish** man. I joined the conversation, and spend another 20 minutes explaining the gospel. The message of truth seemed to get through. I gave him a book on prophecies from the old testament that showed Jesus in the Messiah. He also took other literature. Please pray for S.

Bill seated on the left, is witnessing to another man who stopped by our table. Bill is a very able evangelist who helps us from time to time with our Center City evangelism.

I also was able to use the new battery power megaphone, that our ministry purchased to share biblical verses, and urge people to recognize the reality of God and the need of faith in Jesus. While I preached the word, fellow evangelist are distributing tracts and engaging people in conversation.

Pictured standing behind the table is John, who I met on the outreach on 9/2. He regularly distributes tracts in Center City, and joined us for this evangelism effort. He plans to join us other times. Please pray for these three men who actively share the gospel, Bill, John, and Michael.




Brother Bill below is witnessing to a woman who stop by our table. Later she would pray to receive the Lord and make sure of her salvation.
